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INTRODUCTION

Kawan Sehat Indonesia is dedicated to enhancing healthcare services in rural communities across Eastern Indonesia. In line with our commitment, we propose a series of activities to augment the efficiency, accessibility, and quality of healthcare services provided by Kawan Sehat Agents.

The initial training was conducted in 2022 with 50 participants to enrich the knowledge and skills of non-professional healthcare providers in delivering Primary Medical Care to individuals in their local communities or for most teachers where they teach.

In April 2023, our team visited five sub-districts to conduct the first refills and evaluations. During the monitoring process, we encountered cases that piqued our interest, prompting a deeper exploration of patient progress and the community's living conditions. The last place to make the first assessment round, held at Charis School, provided a digital platforms to discuss the challenges faced and the cases successfully addressed by the Kawan Sehat Agents.



These subsequent activities, or Round II, encompass:

1. Refilling medications in their first aid kits,
2. Providing essential medical teams and supplies in Rumah Kambera,
3. Evaluating and treating cases, and
4. Introducing digital platforms for efficient record-keeping.

OBJECTIVES

Refills

Refilling Medications in the Kawan Sehat Agent's First Aid Kit:

Ensuring that Kawan Sehat Agents' first aid kits are consistently supplied with essential medications.

Medical Team and Supply

Provision of Medical Team (Health Service Assistance) and Medical Supplies for Health Service

Activities: Providing assistance in the form of a medical team and essential medical supplies to facilitate healthcare service activities.



Evaluation

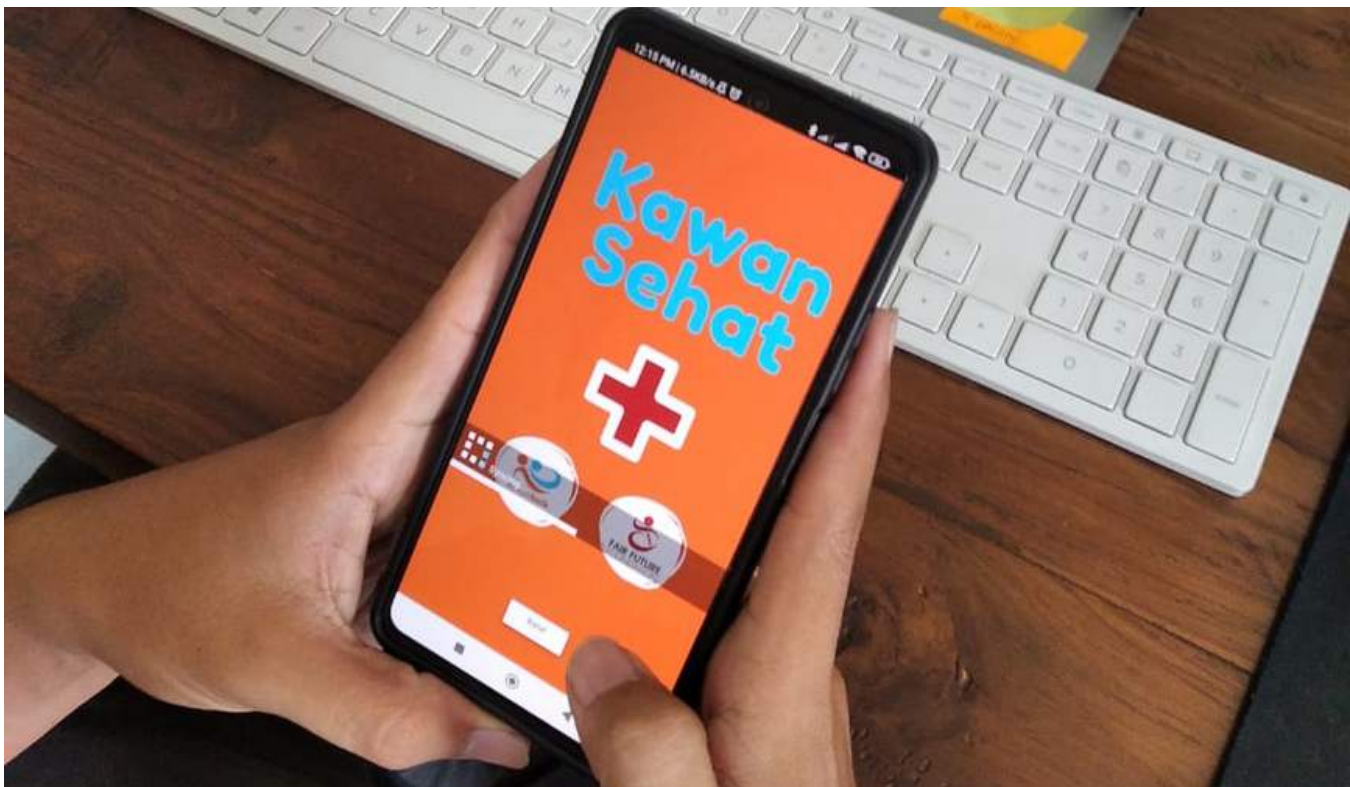
Evaluation and Treatment of Cases by the Medical Team from the Foundation:

Assessing and providing medical care for cases managed by Kawan Sehat Agents, with the support of the Foundation's medical team.

Digital Platforms Support

Development and Testing of Digital Platforms for Case Recording and Drug Usage Reporting:

Exploring the development and trial of digital platforms designed to record cases and report medication usage.



GOALS



REFILLS

Refilling first aid kits is crucial for Kawan Sehat Agents to provide prompt and essential medical assistance, addressing common health concerns and injuries in the communities they serve.

MEDICAL TEAM AND SUPPLY

Deploying a medical team and medical supplies is crucial in improving healthcare services as it enables prompt and comprehensive healthcare delivery, addressing a wide range of medical needs and contributing to the overall well-being of communities.

EVALUATION

The Foundation's medical team provides comprehensive assessment and treatment plans for health issues managed by Sehat Kawan Agents, ensuring improved healthcare quality and effectiveness through a collaborative approach.

DIGITAL PLATFORMS

Digital platforms can streamline medical case recording and medication reporting, increasing data management efficiency and accuracy in healthcare. These tools enhance patient care, making the process more organized, accessible, and time-efficient. It's important to test the digital platforms thoroughly before implementation to resolve any issues.

TIMELINE



The planned timeline spans three months, commencing in November 2023 and concluding in January 2024.

During this period, all activities related to the project will be implemented. This structured timeline allows for a comprehensive and focused execution of various tasks, including preparation, assessment, refilling of medical kits, provision of medical teams and supplies, case evaluation, and introduction of a digital platforms.

Here is the list of medicines and tools typically found in the first aid kit of a Kawan Sehat Agent:

1. Sterile Gauze 16x16
2. Hansaplast Spray 50ml
3. Hansaplast Adhesive Strips
4. Hansaplast Circular Plaster Roll
5. Alcohol 100ml
6. Eucalyptus Oil 60ml
7. Insto - Regular eye drop
8. Caviplex - Vitamin
9. Cetirizine - Anti Allergy
10. Norit - Anti Diarrhea
11. Ketoconazole Cream 10g - Anti-Fungal Cream
12. Hydrocortisone Cream 1%
13. Paracetamol Tablets - Adult Paracetamol
14. Guaifenesin Tablets - Adult Cough Medicine -
15. Ibuprofen
16. Demacolin - Adult Flu Medicine
17. Tremenza Tablets - Child Flu Medicine
18. Coparcetin Tablets - Child Cough Medicine
19. Sanmol Tablets - Child Paracetamol
20. Promedex Tablets - Child Cough Medicine
21. Gentamicin Cream
22. Aloe Vera Gel
23. Petroleum Jelly

These items are typically included to provide Primary Medical Care and address common health issues.
