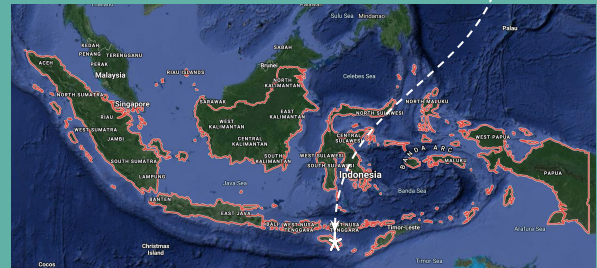
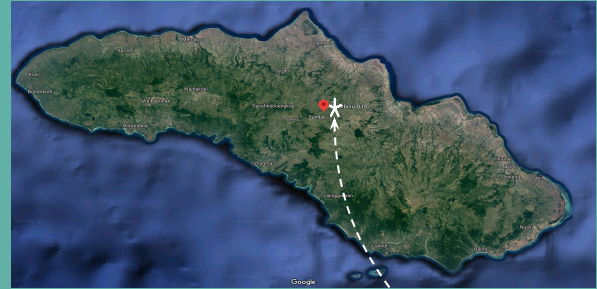

The Mbinudita project is a disaster response action after the school was collapsed in December 2019, the delay of the launch are raised new problems in the education sector and became urgently matter to solve.

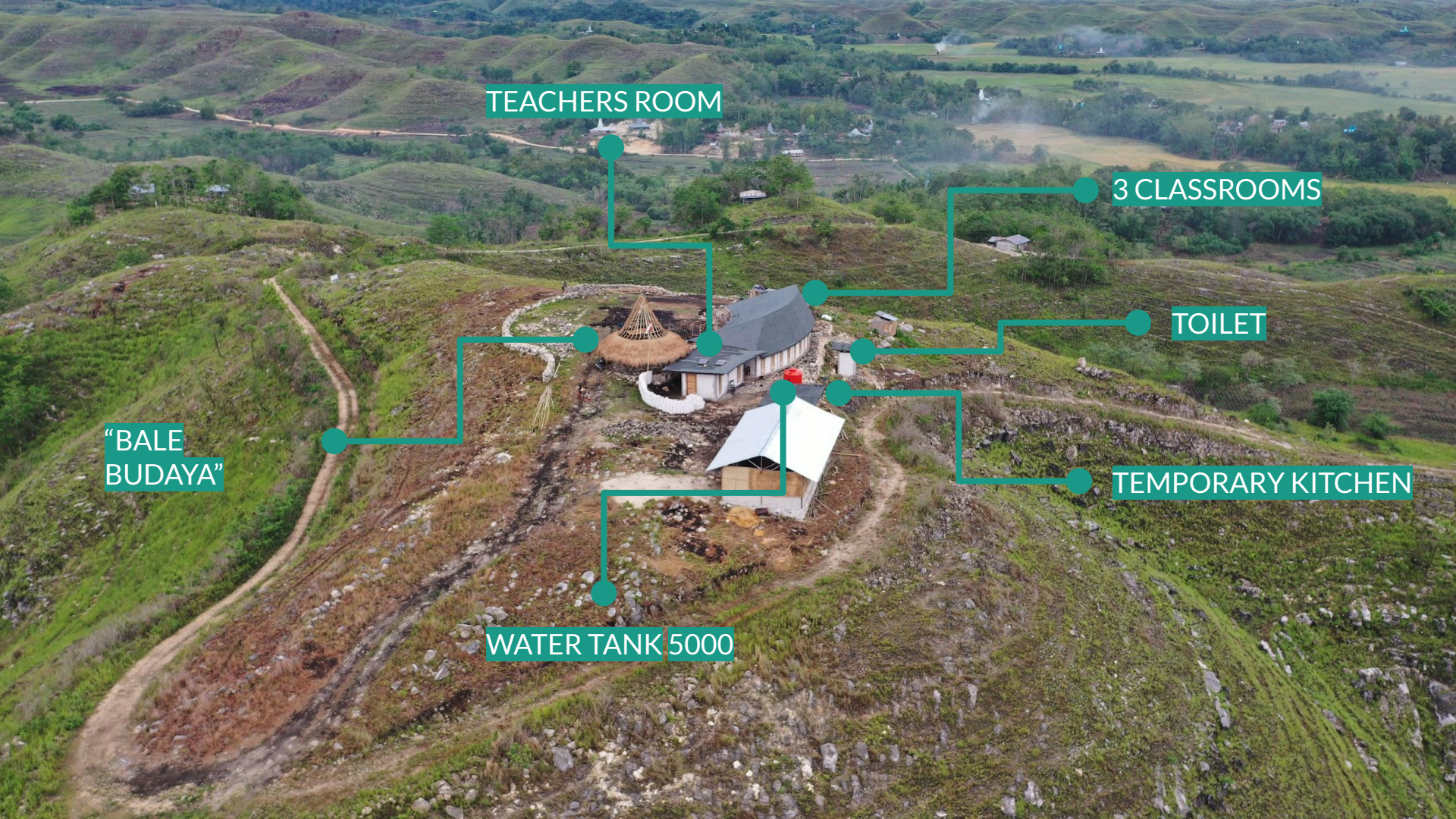
The Foundations and Participants are committed to reconstruct and the building is now stand up the hill of Mbinudita village.

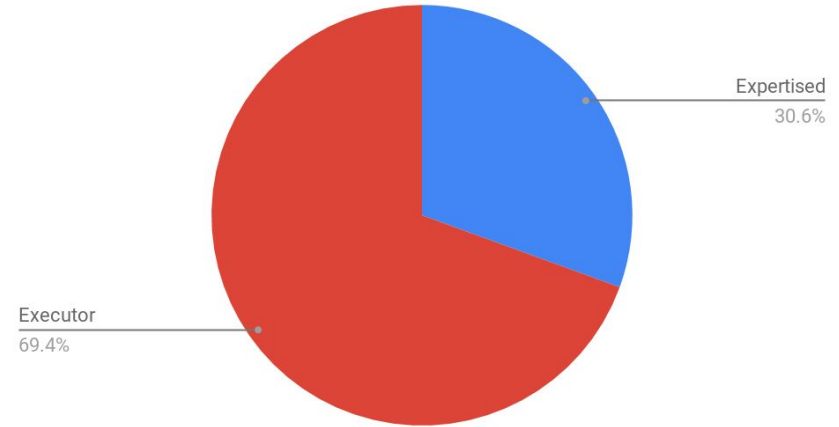

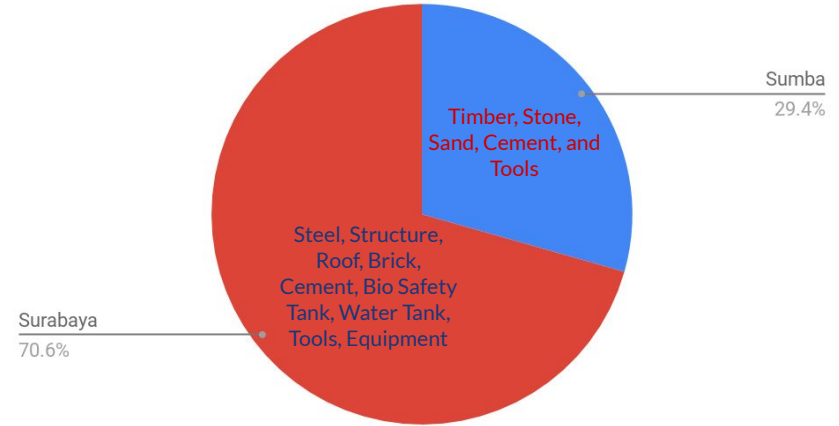

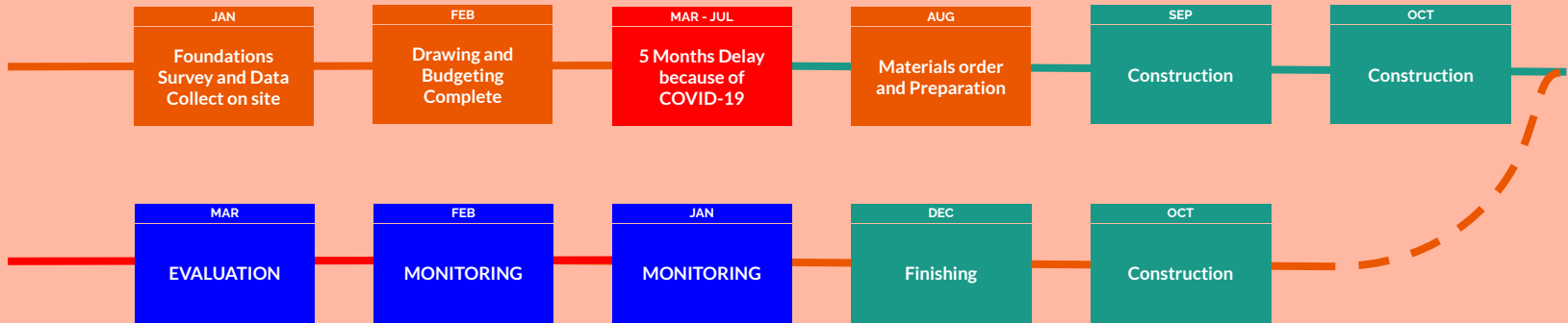
Mbinudita School financial report shown our post expenses during the project in Bali and Sumba since preparation, action, until monitoring and evaluation from December 2019 - 2020.
